



LOOKING FOR A FUN BACKYARD DIY GAME?

This classic DIY Ring Toss project is easy to make and entertaining for parents and kids. With just a few materials, three Worx tools and some creativity, you'll have a fun game the whole family can enjoy.

STEPS

- 1. Lay a tape measure across the circle and mark the center point at 12".
- 2. Lightly sketch the largest square possible around the center point that touches 4 edges of the circle.
- 3. From each corner, make a mark appx 2" in toward the center point.
- You should have 5 points marked out. Next you will insert the 1" paddle bit into the drill and drill about 3/4" of the way through each point. (FIG.A)



5. With your Axis, measure and cut 5 pieces at 18". (FIG.B)



- 6. Paint the board and round dowels or leave as is.
- Insert dowels into the pre-drilled holes. Use glue for additional support if desired or if the fit is too loose. (FIG.C)



RECOMMENDED MATERIALS

- (1) 24" round pine board
- (3) 1x48" round dowels
- · Wood glue
