
CREATE A FESTIVE CANDY CANE DECORATION





STEPS

- Determine what size your candy cane(s) should be based on where you want to display it.
- 2 Draw your candy cane outline on the plywood board.
- 3 Cut out the candy cane using your Axis Recip/Jigsaw in jigsaw mode. (Don't forget to wear eye protection!)
- 4 Sand all of the surfaces, edges and corners using the 20V Oscillating Multi-Tool and the included sanding pad attachment. Wipe the sanded surface with a damp rag to remove any sawdust.
- 5 Paint a base coat of white, covering all surfaces. For candy canes that will go outside, paint a second coat.
- 6 After the base coat is completly dry, mask off diagonal stripes using the painter's tape.
- 7 Paint the red stripes, making sure to extend them to the edges (and around to the back if placing in your yard). Paint a second coat as needed. Once dry, remove the painter's tape.
- 8 For candy canes that will be placed in your yard, attach the wooden mounting stake using wood screws (pre-drill holes with the 20V Switchdriver to minimize splitting) prior to Step 5, painting the whole assembly in Steps 5-7.
- 9 For candy canes that will be mounted on a door or other vertical surface, drill two holes for the twine or wire that will hang the decoration.
- 10 Once the candy canes are finished and placed, celebrate with a warm Holiday drink and cookies.

Bring Holiday spirit to life with this fun and easy candy cane decoration project. Make just one, or make several to spread cheer throughout your yard and in your home. We've listed all the steps, materials and tools needed. This is a good project for the whole family to take on, with easier steps for younger DIYers.

Pro Tip: They make great gifts, too.

RECOMMENDED MATERIALS

- (1) 5/8" x 12" x 36" outdoor-grade plywood board (for large candy cane)
- (1) 5/8" x 8" x 20" outdoor-grade plywood board (for small candy cane)
- (3) #10 x 2" corrosion-resistant flathead wood or deck screws
- 1" x 2" x 24" wooden stake (if using as a yard decoration
- (3) #10 x 1" corrosion-resistant flat-head wood or deck screws (to mount large candycane to the wooden stake)
- Twine or lighweight wire (to hang small candycane from a door or other vertical surface)
- 1 gt of red exterior-grade latex paint
- 1 can of white paint-and-primer spray paint
- 1" wide painter's tape
